Site Address

The facility is located at approximately 400 Staceys Road, Anakie. NB: The entrance gates were built into a farm paddock, not a street address. Therefore, landmarks and photos are more useful in finding the site than solely relying on Google or Apple maps. Gates

The site entrance has two large black sliding gates which are likely to be in the open position for your visit (weekdays). Depending on the time of day, these gates may be closed as you exit the haul road, however they open automatically using an in-ground sensor. Access to the entrance haul road is required 24/7, so we ask that you don't park on the Staceys Road side/south of the gates if waiting to meet other members of your party. If you must wait off Staceys Road, please move inside the gates and to the side so as not to prevent large multi-trailer trucks from entering the gates and forcing them to block Staceys Road.



Haul Road

The Haul road is unsealed with pull out bays to allow safe heavy vehicle traffic all year around. With large rainfall events of recent months the road is potholed and has corrugations. We encourage vehicles to remain below 40km/h at all times and even slower around corners and approaching the floodway.



Site Entrance

Please approach the site entrance with caution as trucks enter and exit via the same gate. Proceed towards the carpark (reverse parking preferred) and make your way to the office to sign in.

Weather

The facility is located on a 2000 ha farm and is very exposed. Calm weather in urban Melbourne or Geelong is not an indicator of the weather at the facility. Please bring appropriate clothing including jacket, sunglasses, hat and sturdy footwear. Visitors will be provided with high visibility vests if moving from the office to the processing areas of the facility.

Emergency Management

A site Chief Warden will be present during site visits and will inform you of any instructions in the case of an emergency. Emergency assembly areas are located at the facility gate and the Staceys Road gate.

A First Aid Kit and AED (Defibrillator) are located in the facility lunchroom next to the office.
